

RESOLUTION 2015-27

RECREATIONAL TRAILS GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE FORT MEADE TRAIL PROJECT

WHEREAS, the United States of America and the State of South Dakota have authorized grants from the Recreational Trails Program (RTP) to public bodies to aid in acquisition and maintenance of recreational trails; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sturgis desires to participate in the South Dakota Recreational Trails Grant Program for construction of an approximate three mile Fort Meade Trail Project.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That the City Manager is hereby authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the City of Sturgis with the United States Department of Transportation Federal Highway Administration, through the State of South Dakota State Parks, Department of Game, Fish and Park for a RTO grant to aide financing the Fort Meade Trail Project for the City of Sturgis, South Dakota and its residents.
2. That the City Manager of the City of Sturgis is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the above mentioned federal and/or state agencies may reasonably request in connection with the application which is hereby authorized to be filed.
3. That the City of Sturgis shall provide a minimum of 20% of the total cost of the project by means of a monetary contribution and will assume all responsibility in the operation and maintenance of the project upon completion of construction, for the reasonable life expectancy of the trail.
4. That the City of Sturgis shall dedicate for park and recreation purposes the use of the real property identified in the authorized application.
