

PROCEEDINGS OF THE STURGIS CITY COUNCIL

The Common Council of the City of Sturgis met in special session starting at 5:30 p.m. on Monday, June 27, 2016 at the Community Center Theater at 1401 Lazelle Street. Present: Mayor Mark Carstensen, Alderpersons Jason Anderson, Mike Bachand, Rod Bradley, Tony Dargatz, Steve Keszler, David Martinson and Ronald Waterland. Also present: City Manager Daniel Ainslie and City Attorney Barnier. Absent: Adam Martin.

The meeting was called to order at 5:30 pm.

City Manager Ainslie announced that the following five people will be on duty at the Fire Hall on July 2, 3 and 4 from 8:00 pm to 12:00 midnight in case of fires. The City will be paying them \$15.00 an hour. Cody Heupel, Seth Schwartz, Kaleb Zook, Tanner Urbaniak and Micky Montanio.

City Manager Ainslie gave a PowerPoint presentation on the 5 year Capital Improvement plan for the City. This presentation will be placed on the City Website.

The following concerns were brought up. Lions Park should not be improved as it is too close to the highway. Rose Park should have new playground equipment and be better taken care of. Building anything in a flood zone should not be allowed. A question was asked about what the City is going to do with Sly Hill and the City Constitutional Debt limit that was mentioned in the presentation.

The Council was commended for doing this strategic planning.
