

RESOLUTION 2011-09
A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING PARTICIPATION IN THE SOUTH DAKOTA
RECREATIONAL TRAILS GRANT PROGRAM

WHEREAS, this resolution authorizes participation in the South Dakota Recreational Trails Grant Program for Construction of Additional Bike Path from end of Deadman Trail and Raccoon Road to First Avenue.

WHEREAS, the United States of America and the State of South Dakota have authorized the making of grants from the Recreational Trails Program (RTP) to public bodies to aid in acquisition and maintenance of recreational trails.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED:

1. That City Manager is hereby authorized to execute and file an application on behalf of the City of Sturgis with the U.S. Department of Transportation Federal Highway Administration, through the State of South Dakota State Parks, Department of Game, Fish, and Parks, for an RTP grant to aid financing the Deadman Trail Project for the City of Sturgis, South Dakota and its Citizens.
2. That City Manager of the City of Sturgis is hereby authorized and directed to furnish such information as the above mentioned federal and/or state agencies may reasonably request in connection with the application which is hereby authorized to be filed.
3. That the City of Sturgis shall provide a minimum of 20% of the total cost of the project by means of a monetary contribution; and will assume all responsibility in the operation and maintenance of the project upon completion of construction, for the reasonable life expectancy of the trail.
4. That the City of Sturgis shall dedicate for park and recreation purposes the use of the real property identified in the authorized application.
