

PROCEEDINGS OF THE STURGIS CITY COUNCIL SPECIAL MEETING —  
June 27, 2012.

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof, the Common Council of the City of Sturgis met in special session on Wednesday June 27, 2012 at 5:00 p.m. at City Hall in conference room B to act upon a renewal for a on/off sale malt beverage license for Emporium of Design, LLC/Road Kill Café and also to approve a pyrotechnics show at the Sturgis Saloon. Present: Mayor Mark Carstensen, Council members, Joe DesJarlais, David Hersrud, Marcia Johnston Jamie McVay (by phone) Tim Potts, Kelly Vasknetz and Ron Waterland. City Attorney Greg Barnier was also present. Absent: Dane Sundstrom.

Mayor Mark Carstensen called the meeting to order.

Mayor Mark Carstensen led everyone in the Pledge of Allegiance.

After a briefing from City Attorney Barnier and a discussion with Attorney Dale Hansen, representing the owners, a motion was made by Hersrud, second from DesJarlais to deny the renewal of the on/off sale malt beverage license for Emporium of Design, LLC/Road Kill Café based on location and character. Further discussion followed.

Motion by Hersrud, second by DesJarlais with Carstensen, DesJarlais, Hersrud, McVay, Potts, Vasknetz and Waterland voting yes and Johnston voting nay to amend the previous motion to deny the renewal of the on/off sale malt beverage license for Emporium of Design, LLC/Road Kill Café based on location only.

The original amended motion was voted upon and carried with Carstensen, DesJarlais, Hersrud, McVay, Potts, Vasknetz and Waterland voting yes and Johnston voting nay. The renewal of the on/off sale malt beverage license for Emporium of Design, LLC/Road Kill Café was denied.

The Council was presented with a request that pyrotechnics be allowed at a performance at the Sturgis Saloon Company venue. Motion by Potts, second by Johnston and carried with all members voting yes to allow a pyrotechnics show at the Sturgis Saloon Company on Friday, June 29, 2012.

The Council was presented with the letter of the SVFD Chief, Tom Trigg, requesting that no fireworks be allowed within the City for the July 4<sup>th</sup> period. As the matter was not on the meeting agenda, it will be considered at the July 2nd meeting of the Council.

Motion by McVay, second by Vasknetz and carried with all members voting yes to adjourn at 5:41 pm.
