

RESOLUTION 2012-10

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING CITY MANAGER DANIEL AINSLIE TO SIGN A RIGHT OF WAY PERMIT AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF SOUTH DAKOTA

WHEREAS the City of Sturgis developed and built the Deadman Bike Path with financial assistance through a grant from the South Dakota Department of Game, Fish and Parks, and

WHEREAS the Deadman Bike Path as designed and constructed crosses a portion of the right of way for Interstate 90, and

WHEREAS the use or occupancy of any dedicated state highway Right of Way in South Dakota requires an agreement with the state Department of Transportation, and

WHEREAS the City of Sturgis and state Department of Transportation have had staff prepare a Use of Right of Way Permit to formally recognize that long term use of a limited portion of the right of way of Interstate 90 for this beneficial purpose,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is hereby **RESOLVED** that Daniel Ainslie, Sturgis City Manager, is hereby authorized to sign and execute that Use of Right of Way Permit on behalf of the City of Sturgis.
