

RESOLUTION 2012-33
A RESOLUTION RESTRICTING THE USE OF FIREWORKS

The Common Council of the City of Sturgis, Meade County, South Dakota, hereby resolves as follows:

WHEREAS the Common Council received a request from the Fire Chief that fireworks not be allowed in City limits due to the extreme fire danger.

WHEREAS pursuant to Sturgis City Ordinance Title 12, Chapter 12.08, Section 12.08.04 the use of fireworks within the limits of the city may be restricted by resolution of the City Council as the City Council may deem necessary due to the existence of heightened fire danger.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED The Sturgis City Council deems it necessary due to the existence of heightened fire danger to prohibit the use of fireworks which includes use of sparklers and other small fireworks within the limits of the City and thus no fireworks shall be allowed within the City or within one mile thereof commencing 6 a.m. July 3 and ending 12 a.m. July 5, 2012.
