

RESOLUTION 2013-60

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO SIGN THE FUNDING AGREEMENT
BETWEEN THE SOUTH DAKOTA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION AND THE CITY
OF STURGIS FOR DESIGN, LETTING AND CONSTRUCTION OF A RECREATIONAL
TRAIL CONNECTION**

WHEREAS, the City of Sturgis desires to complete a multi-use trail connection along Otter and Raccoon Road; and

WHEREAS, the new connection will combine the First Avenue Path Spur with the Moose Drive Path; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sturgis believes that Multiuse paths are a vital segment of the community's transportation network and are a significant contributor to the City's high quality of life; and

WHEREAS, in 2013, the City of Sturgis has budgeted the required 18.05% match to pay for the local share of the proposed project; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sturgis was awarded a grant of \$123,000 from the State of South Dakota Transportation Enhancement Funds to help pay for the costs of the City Utility expansions; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sturgis understands and agrees to the conditions set forth in the State of South Dakota Funding Agreement for the Transportation Enhancement Program; and

WHEREAS, the City of Sturgis desires to enter into such agreement, a copy of which is attached hereto.

NOW THEREFORE, Mayor Mark Carstensen is hereby authorized to execute said Funding Agreement between the State of South Dakota and the City of Sturgis for the construction of the Otter and Raccoon Road Multi Use Trail connection.
